HOW TO GET HERE

We are very easy to drive to from the Skye Bridge or ferry, along good roads. (No single track.)

- 2 minutes' drive from the Armadale ferry terminal. (Ferries from Mallaig – 25 minute crossing, operated by CalMac ferries.)
- 20 miles from the Skye Bridge, approx 30 minutes' drive. (16 miles south of Broadford)

PLANNING YOUR VISIT

We are usually open March – November.

Main season:

Open daily 1 April – 31 October, 9.30am - 5.30pm
(last entrance 5pm)

Low season:

March and November. Contact us to confirm times.

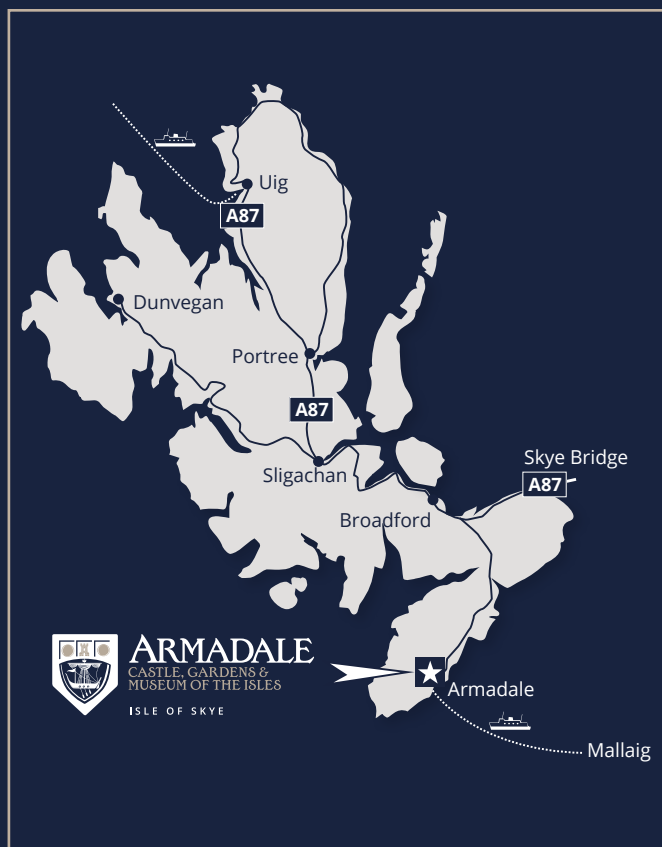
Most tour groups allow 1.5 – 2 hours for their visit. However if your group only has 1 hour available they will still be able to enjoy a good experience.

Why not extend your trip on the Sleat Peninsula – the 'Garden of Skye'? Nearby attractions include the recently opened Torabhaig Distillery, on the Hebridean Whisky Trail, which offers small group tours (www.torabhaig.com), and high quality arts and crafts shops at Armadale Pier.

ACCESSIBILITY

We welcome visitors with access needs. Please contact us if you require further information.

- All indoor facilities are on one level.
- Main routes in the gardens are wheelchair friendly, and there are plenty of places to sit.
- Accessible toilets are available in the museum and café.
- A wheelchair can be borrowed free of charge subject to availability. Mobility scooters may be available, please enquire.
- An audio guide describing the museum for visually impaired visitors is available in our museum. Some of the exhibits are designed to be touched.



We are conveniently located near the Armadale ferry terminal and just 30 minutes from the Skye Bridge.
